

•**Our Mission:** To promote access to quality education, healthcare, food security, safe water and environment conservation to the most needy in rural areas.

## **PFGF Programmes**

•Quality Education – To enhance educational standards in rural areas as well as academic excellence and talent development. We also aim to create awareness about sustainable livelihood initiatives especially other sources of income apart from traditional farming and cattle rearing; for both the youth and the marginalized communities.

•Healthcare – To promote healthy eating habits and awareness creation on communicable and non-communicable diseases affecting the community and nation at large.




