# Partnership models

- Company-led or branded programs where volunteer organisations / NGOs may engage to provide supporting infrastructure
- NGO-led programs where companies / employees may engage through employee volunteering or contribution of other resources. Usually supported by employee volunteering / CSR manager
- Joint programs where NGO and company or a group of partners come together to build a targeted program. Usually supported by employee volunteering / CSR manager
- Employee volunteer-led partnerships. May involve some or very little employer support. Driven by employee volunteer personal motivation
