



## THE 2018 IAVE WORLD VOLUNTEER CONFERENCE

Since the very first conference in 1970, the IAVE World Volunteer Conference has been the premier gathering point for volunteer leaders from throughout the world. The conference attracts people who share a commitment to volunteering as a means to build understanding across borders through the active engagement of people in service to their communities, to their societies and to the world.

Well-attended, well-received, and well-reviewed, IAVE's conference provides access to an international group prominent in the field of volunteering, with around 1,000 participants representing global, national and local leaders of volunteering from civil society organizations (NGOs), grassroots community initiatives, business, faith-based organizations, education and government

For the first time in IAVE history the World Volunteer Conference will take place in Germany. The city of Augsburg was founded more than 2,000 years ago by the Romans and is one of the oldest cities in Germany. Today it is a wonderful city in southern Germany with tremendous diversity, commitment to citizenship and sustainability, and impressive Bavarian and Swabian traditions and innovations.

In 2018, the Volunteer Center Augsburg and the City of Augsburg will be the host organizations for the World Volunteer Conference. Volunteer Center Augsburg's mission is to foster volunteering in Augsburg by informing and consulting its citizens, enhancing the communication between volunteers, and by supporting organizations and citizens' initiatives for increased volunteer commitment and dedication to social responsibility. The City of Augsburg is recognized in Germany for its network of volunteering (Alliance of Augsburg) and has been awarded the National Award for Volunteering and the National Award of Sustainability.


